

Trials Sporting Regulations – 2026

TSR.8 MOTORCYCLES

Motorcycles must comply with Appendix D of the National Sporting Code. ~~Prior to the start of each Event all machines shall be examined to ensure that they comply with ACU specifications.~~ & ACU specifications.

At all times during an event, it is the sole responsibility of the rider/parent to ensure that their entered motorcycle is of a safe and sound condition and no defects are present.

When the event uses the public highway, it is the sole responsibility of the rider to present a machine complying with all Road Traffic Act(s) requirements. Organisers may at their discretion, allow riders to share the same machine in a Closed to Club Trial held on private land.

Technical Control will consist of the following minimum checks for conformity when the rider arrives at the waiting zone / start line.

- a. Rider has Motorcycle Helmet on
- b. Youth Rider has Back protector on
- c. The Clerk of the Course can select random machines for checks at any time during a meeting.

Clubs may, if they wish, offer a full Technical Control Check, which details should be stipulated in the event SR's.

Any machine damaged in an incident can be recalled by the Technical Officer for re-inspection before being ridden again at the meeting.
