ITEMS FOR 2020

Marshals Training

The Marshals training documents – used for the first time in 2019 – will be available to all clubs for 2020 Following the completion of the training, the forms, together with a pink affiliation form, should be forwarded to the ACU Track Racing Secretary, and trained Marshals will then receive an ACU 'Marshal Registration' card – a number of Marshals have already received these.

Photographers at Track Racing Events

The Track Racing Committee (TRC), have produced a set of guidance notes for photographers attending race meetings. This document should be issued (by the Meeting Secretary) to any photographer wishing to be 'Signed On' at a Track Racing Event. Any club wanting copies of these guidance notes should contact the ACU Track Racing Secretary.

Licences and Insurance Fees:

The TRC are pleased to confirm that for 2020 there will be no change in the cost of licences. There is now a 'One Licence' application form available for all Off-Road disciplines

<u>Wild Cards for the British Masters & Masters</u> Qualification Championships:

Masters Qualification Championship there is now a facility for Wild Cards into the Championship.

British Masters – Solo 2 Wild Cards for the Organising Club (to be agreed by TRC) and 2 for the TRC.

Sidecars Up to 2 Wild Cards for TRC.

Grading Lists:

The 'Live Grading List' trialled during 2017 has now been adopted by the ACU TRC. The grading list is updated on a monthly basis and clubs have been co-operating well with the ACU and TRC member Gareth Bemister by sending in results within the requested timeframe. The names of Centre Recorders have now been taken out of the Handbook, and the TRC would like to thank all the recorders for their help and assistance over many years.

Random Drugs & Alcohol Testing

During 2019, Track Racing was subject to random drugs testing along with other disciplines within the ACU. Although there is a cost element to this, the ACU Directors are committed to this procedure which will continue throughout the 2020 season



<u>Technical Issues – reference numbers as per the Track</u> <u>Racing Standing Regulations as contained in the 2020 ACU</u> <u>Handbook:</u>

GT 2.6

No machines should be started before the Technical Inspection has taken place.

New wording on Dirt Deflectors (GT regs 4.4) to reflect the current FIM requirements and text.

4.6 ALL CONTROL LEVERS

All ball ended levers (fitted to any machine), must be a minimum of 16mm min diameter. The end of levers when closed must not be situated wider than the furthest extremity of the handle

4.10 LANYARD

The lanyard must be non-elastic and made of one constant material. The length of the cut-out lanyard must be as short as possible

4.11 CARBURETTORS OR OTHER AIR INPUT CONTROL INSTRUMENTS

All Track Racing engines must be fitted with one carburettor with a maximum choke size of 26mm for 140cc and 34mm for 250cc, 350cc and 500cc engines + 0.1mm circular shape.

4.13 CHASSIS CONSTRUCTION

The use of titanium in the construction of the frame, the front forks, handlebars, swinging arm and swinging arm spindle, front and rear wheel spindles **is strictly forbidden**.

The use of light alloys for wheel spindles is also forbidden. The use of titanium alloy nuts and bolts **is allowed**.

4.15 FUEL

Methanol, of a commercial make, is the only permitted fuel. The use of octane boosters is forbidden. On liquid cooled engines, an overflow pipe must direct any overflowing coolant away from the rider and passenger into a catch tank.

The use of fuel additives is prohibited, with the exception of oil for two stroke engines.

Fuel injection is permitted.

Fuel tanks must be constructed of a material that will neither shatter nor splinter upon impact.

FIM / FIME EVENTS ONLY 250,500cc and 500cc sidecar -Rev Limiters will be compulsory for 2020

2.7.1 Practicing

New text:

Solo: Youth & GT140cc should be run as separate practice sessions.

2.8 On Track Starts:

Youth events: 'On Track' starting gates ARE NOT permitted at any youth only event. If a combined youth and adult event is being staged, then the organising club must supply an 'Off Track' starting gate for the youth competitors

2.28 RIGHTS OF PROTEST

No protest can be accepted against decisions made by the Clerk of Course or Referee (where appointed), Chief Technical Steward against matters that are considered a Statement of Fact. Specifically these include:

A ruling on a heat result

A ruling on a racing incident (such as articles 2.11, 2.122, 2.16, 2.21, 2.22, 2.23)

A ruling on a Technical Matters

At all meetings a separate, private enclosed area is to be provided away from the public area in order to deal with any protests that may arise.
