Starting Order – Determined by ballot

Start Time - First rider 10.30am and at 1 minute intervals, by Class

Course – all on private land. 12 Sections 3 laps per day

Time Limit - to be advised in Final Instructions

Method of Marking – The Championship will be held under **TSR22B NON STOP**

Entry Fee - £40.

To be received by the Secretary of the meeting on or before **August 2nd 2016** together with the correct entry fee of **£40** Final Instructions will be sent by Email address supplied. All cheques to be made payable to **North Eastern Centre ACU. Individual cheques to accompany each individual entry – no multiple cheques will be accepted.**

No telephone, Email or late entries will be accepted.

Assistants – riders may register one Assistant to accompany them on the course, provided he/she is not riding a machine. The Assistant must be a minimum age of 18. The Assistant must sign on at the start. The Assistant will be issued with identification, which must be worn and clearly visible to all Officials.

Return of Fees: An entry fee will only be returned if the event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours. **Riders who cancel their entry after the closing date will NOT receive a refund.**

Results - will be available on the day. They will be posted later on Trials Central and by post if an s.a.e. is provided. Protests in this Championship must be submitted within 30 minutes of the announcement of results provided the results are displayed within 30 minutes of the last rider finishing.
