Announcement: The North Berks MCC will organize a National trial held under an ACU Special Permit. The event will be organized in accordance with the ACU National Sporting Code, the ACU Trials Standing Regulations with the following amendments, together with these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions that may be issued.

Method of Marking

The method of Marking will be as TSR22.A Stop Permitted with the following amendments.

a) There will be no penalty if the machine moves backwards without footing. Any backward movement whilst footing will be classed as a failure.
