ANNOUNCMENT: The Neath Motor Club will organise the National Fred Rist Trial for Solo Motorcycles held under the ACU National Sporting Code, the Standing Trials Regulations, the Trail Bike Championship Regulations these Supplementary Regulations and any Final instructions that may be issued.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to members of ACU Affiliated Clubs who are holders of a current Trials Registration, Enduro Licence, or Licence holders of the SACU. (Any riders from other Federations including Irish entrants must produce Start Permission and proof of Insurance from their FMN)

Open to all riders and machines that are fully legal to use the Public Highway. All machines must be equiped with Tyres as defined in TSR8 and be silenced to the requirements of a Trial Machine.

START: Magor Design. Car Park - Resolven - which is just off A465 - Neath to Merthyr Rd. (Was Nidum Engineering)

START TIME: 9.00am

COURSE: Course will consist of approx 60 - 70 miles which will include Public Highway as well as off-road tracks and trails. There will be approx 30 Observed Sections. Similar to previous years but may be reversed. Special test may be used to resolve ties.as per ACU rules

All competitors MUST give way to horses and walkers and close all gates where indicated to do so. Travelling Marshall's will report any competitor who is seen riding in a dangerous or irresponsible manner and any such reported rider will be liable to exclusion and disciplinary action. "Please ensure your registration number plate is clean when travelling on the road"

THERE MAY BE A LUNCH/RE-FUEL BREAK (back at Start point) at around half distance. This stop may be allocated a specific time which will mean riders being timed in and out(To allow Observers time to travel between sections).Further details will be included in Final Instructions/ **Start Information.**

CLASSES: NOTE - All bikes must have TRIALS tyres fitted on the rear wheel. **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS**

ACU Trail Bike Championship Class: All machines must comply with the following:

Machine wheelbase must not be less than 1350mm.

Machine must have a minimum 5 Litre fuel tank.

Machine must have a dual seat of at least 350mm long.

Machine must be equipped with full working lights.

No converted trial bikes permitted in this class.

ACU CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE FIRST 15 PLACES IN THE ABOVE CLASS

The following additional classes are included - but are not eligible for Championship points (B) EASY ROUTE TRAIL BIKE CLASS - As above but riders will NOT be eligible for championship points.

- (C) EASY ROUTE ENDURO MACHINE CLASS Note There will be strict noise control
- (D) FEMALE CLASS: On any machine from as specified in Classes above.
