**Class B – Any air-cooled machine plus one of criteria points (Example Yamaha TY 250 Mono with drum brakes)**

**Class C – Any air-cooled machine plus two of criteria points (Example Yamaha TY 250 with drum brakes and twin-shocks; Bultaco Sherpa, Montesa 348/349 etc)**

**Class D – Any air-cooled machine plus three of criteria points (Example James/BSA/Ariel/Francis Barnett with twin-shocks, drum brakes and British engine)**

**Drum Brakes**

**British Engine**

**Entry Restrictions:** Maximum of 120 riders.....

**Start.** The start will be at Brookhouse Brickworks, Brookhouse, Lancaster, LA2 9PR (Nearest)

The first rider will start at 10am the rest as per Championship Regulations

**Approximate length & number of laps will be 3 miles, 2 laps of up to 20 sections.....**
