Classes:

Class A: Any air- cooled machine: (Example: Yamaha TY250 Mono with disc brakes)

Class B: Any air-cooled machine plus one of criteria points (Example: Yamaha TY250 Mono with drum brakes)

Class C: Any air-cooled machine plus two of criteria points (Example: Yamaha TY250 with drum brakes and twin- shocks)

Class D: Any air-cooled machine plus three of criteria points (Example: James/BSA/Ariel/Francis Barnett etc with twin-shocks, drum brakes and British engine)

Criteria Points: Twin-shocks Drum brakes British engine

Start. The start will be at Parkwood off Road Centre, Tong, Bradford BD4 0RR Lat 53.772155 Long -1.671843

The first rider will start at 11.00am and then at 1 minute intervals.

Course. The event will be one course for all classes. It is all on private land and consists of streams, gullies and rocks. Approximate total length of course 3 miles with 3 laps of 14/15 sections (to be confirmed in final instruction). Sections to be ridden consecutively on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

Method of marking. As per TSR 22b (no stop). Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23.

Awards. To the winners in each class. The overall winner of the series will receive a perpetual award and an ACU medal at the annual ACU awards presentation.

Protests: As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU

Any instructions on the day will have equal force with these Supplementary Regulations.

A support event will be run in conjunction with the Air-Cooled National, using a separate course. This event is open to adult Novices and A B C Youths and entry can be made on the day.
