Announcement – The Yeadon Guiseley & District Motor Club Ltd will organize a National trial held under the National Sporting Code, the Standing Trials Regulations of the ACU, the 2016 ACU Acklams BETA British Ladies & Girls Trials Championship and any final instructions that may be issued.

Eligibility – All riders in the Championship classes must be of the female gender. Classes for girls are as defined under youth riders TSR1.

Starting Order – Determined by ballot

Start Time - First rider 10.30am and at 1 minute intervals, by Class

Course - all on private land. The number of sections and laps to be advised in Final Instructions

Time Limit - to be advised in Final Instructions

Method of Marking - The Championship will be held under TSR22B NON STOP

Entry Fee - £25 this includes the cost of an Assistant.

To be received by the Secretary of the meeting on or before FIRST POST Friday, 3rd June 2016 together with the correct entry fee of £25 plus 1 SAE's for Final Instructions unless an Email address is supplied. All cheques to be made payable to Yeadon Guiseley DMC Ltd. Individual cheques to accompany each individual entry – no multiple cheques will be accepted.

No telephone, Email or late entries will be accepted.

Assistants – riders may register one Assistant to accompany them on the course, <u>provided he/she is not riding a machine</u>. The Assistant must be a minimum age of 18. The Assistant must sign on at the start. The Assistant will be issued with identification, which must be worn and clearly visible to all Officials.

Return of Fees: An entry fee will only be returned if the event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours. **Riders who cancel their entry after the closing date will NOT receive a refund.**
