1. JURISDICTION: held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the Standing Motocross Regulations of the organising Centre, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions that may be issued.

2. ENTRIES: to be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting. Please send an sae or give a valid email address.

Entry fee: £25. ACU day licence if required: £15 to be paid with entry. **This meeting WILL use transponders.** If you don't already have one you can hire one on the day for £10, with a £10 refundable deposit. All cheques payable to **NMCC Ltd.** Numbers 1 to 55 being issued only on a first come first served basis. Closing date: 3rd December 2016.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

3. ELIGIBILITY: Closed to Club Event for fully paid up members of NMCC Ltd.

ALL RIDERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND ATLEAST 1 FULL DAY OF THE WORKING PARTY WEEKEND ON DECEMBER 10th & 11th & THE CLEARING UP PARTY ON TUESDAY 27TH DECEMBER - **FAILURE TO DO THIS WILL RESULT IN YOUR ACCEPTANCE BEING REVOKED & A RESERVE RIDER TAKING YOUR PLACE ... WE CANNOT RUN THIS EVENT WITHOUT ASSISTANCE FROM RIDERS**

4. WORKING PARTY WEEKEND: SATURDAY 10th DECEMBER & SUNDAY 11th DECEMBER 2016 at 10am. **CLEARING UP PARTY:** Tuesday 27th DECEMBER 2016 at 10am.

5. GENERAL: ALL RIDERS MUST PROVIDE A MARSHAL TO TAKE CHARGE OF A MARSHAL POINT, WHO MUST BE OVER 18 YRS OF AGE, MUST SIGN ON BEFORE PRACTICE & WEAR REFLECTIVE BIB PROVIDED. THIS MARSHAL MUST REMAIN AT THEIR POST AND IS NOT PERMITTED TO ASSIST ANY RIDER STUCK IN MUD. PLEASE NOMINATE YOUR MARSHAL ON THE ENTRY FORM.

6. COURSE: Length 1 ½ miles approx - Prepare your bike for water & mud! **Tear-offs** ARE allowed at this track.

7. AWARDS: **1st Place:** Ladies Cup **2nd Place:** Griff Jenkins Cup **3rd Place:** Harrison Cup

Margaret Anderson Cup: Highest Placed Junior **Ashley Rogers Cup:** 1st Novice (no previous wins at NMCC)

Doug Desborough Cup: Oldest Finisher **Doug Griffin Tankard:** Youngest Finisher. RIDERS CAN ONLY WIN ONE AWARD.

IMPORTANT: RIDERS MUST COMPLETE ATLEAST 20% OF THE WINNER'S LAPS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TROPHY.

8. PADDOCK PASS_will be issued to each rider as ACCEPTANCE of entry - this allows 1 rider & 1 mechanic in ONE vehicle as there is limited space in Paddock area. **NO PIT BIKES OR QUADS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PITS OR ANYWHERE ON SITE.**

9. NUMBER PLATE WASH PROVIDED: RIDERS FAILING TO STOP WILL HAVE 1 LAP DEDUCTED

10. REFUELLING AREA PROVIDED: REFUELLING CAN ONLY BE DONE IN THIS AREA - ENGINES TO BE CUT

11. MEDICATION: You may be asked to take part in drugs test: It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are using any medication.

12. Insurance: The insurance for this event will be basic (limit of liability £10m). Medical malpractice insurance (limit of liability £5m) is included. There is NO personal accident insurance for competitors. Competitors are therefore strongly recommended to purchase such cover which is available through the Locktons website: www.lockstonmotorsport.com or the ACU website.

This event is held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto-Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued for the meeting. The ACU National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations are published annually in the ACU Handbook.

Entry declaration: I / we the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:-

- I / we hereby declare that I / we have had the opportunity to read, and that I / we understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I / we further declare that I am / we are physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am / we are competent to do so.
- I / we confirm that I / we understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I / we confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I / we compete on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose.
- I / we confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that it / they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I / we agree that I am / we are required to register our arrival by "signing on" at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of my/our practice or first competition, whichever occurs first.
- I/we understand and accept that as the Supplementary Regulations state the Insurance cover for this event is "Basic" there is no Personal Accident cover for Competitors and Liability cover in respect of any claim made by third parties is limited to £10 million and £5 million for Medical Mal-practice.

Acknowledgement of the risks of motorsport: I / we understand that by taking part in this event I / we are exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I / we acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I / we may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my / our voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I / we have read the above and acknowledge that my / our participation in motorsport is entirely at my / our own risk.
